

# Stoddard County Public Health Center

2012 Community Health Survey

July 2012

#### Overview and Methodology:

Health Care providers must rely upon community involvement and experience based concepts to assure that their future plans for the provision of healthcare will produce enduring, positive results, and meet the requirements of the population. The Stoddard County Public Health Center is working in collaboration with partnering county agencies to involve as many residents as possible in the local health care planning process. By this empowerment process residents will take ownership for the problems facing the county and participate in designing a delivery system to solve these problems.


The information in the following pages are the results from the county community health survey performed by the Stoddard County Public Health Center in collaboration with partnering agencies. The information will be used to guide discussion to assess access to care, and make recommendations to redesign systems, reconstruct community services, in ways that will maximize the health and productivity of the population.

#### **Respondent Characteristics:**


There were about 300 complete surveys, although not all respondents completed all questions. The respondents generally reflected the age, income, and racial composition of Stoddard County. Surveys were collected from all townships of Stoddard County including a small number collected from the Stoddard County Public Health Center's website. A majority of the respondents were clients entering the Stoddard County Public Health Center. About 95% of the survey respondents identified themselves as female, and about 6% identified themselves as male; the population of Stoddard County, by contrast, is 52% female and 48% male. Survey respondents identified themselves as 1.3% Asian, 0.7% Black/African American, 94.6% Caucasian/White, 2% Hispanic/Latino, 1% Native American; the Counties diversity matches the respondents with 1% Asian, 0.9% Black/African American, 96.5% Caucasian/White, 1.2% Hispanic/Latino, 0.4% Native American. The county yearly household income and highest level of education received are similar to the respondents reporting as well.




Do you live inside the city limits?






What would you say that generally your health is?






Do you have a family physician?


If yes, is he/she Local?


Do you currently have regular dental check-ups?

Within the past year, what type of health services did you or your child receive outside Stoddard County? Check all that apply.












If you smoke, dip, or chew, would you like to quit?






On average, how many fruits and vegetables do you eat every day?




Last week, how many days did you exercise or do physical activity for more than 30 minutes?




Last week, how many meals did you eat out at a fast food restaurant?










